PARKS AND RECREATION DIRECTOR UPDATES

Parks director Devon Fredrickson told the board the meetings moving forward would be quarterly.

LAKE JACKSONVILLE BOATING ACCESS PROJECT

Parks director Devon Fredrickson told the board when the project was rebid, there were four bids received, one being right in line with the budget. Mr. Fredrickson said the winning bid was submitted by Heartbeat Construction at just under \$1.8 million. Mr. Fredrickson said that construction kicked off in November with estimated completion and ribbon-cutting being the summer of 2025. Mr. Fredrickson updated the board on the construction's progress.

BLACK VULTURE DETERMENT

Parks Dir. Devin Fredrickson told the board he is working with the USDA regarding the black vulture issue. Mr. Fredrickson updated the board on the progress and procedures of the determent.

LAKE CLOSURE STANDARDS AND PROCESS
