Mr. Hubbard asked Mr. Neal Holland of Stokes and Associates to speak regarding item 11 on the proposed agenda, that item being the notice to issue certificates of obligation. Mr. Holland told the council these c/o's would be used to secure a low interest loan from the Texas Water Development Board. Mr. Holland said the loan would then be used for a new lift station near Bolton and Sunnydale as well as the installation of several thousand feet of 18" sewer line from S. Bolton the east side of town to an existing lift station. City Manager James Hubbard reviewed the agenda with council. Mr. Hubbard reviewed with council the proposed garage sale ordinance. Police Chief Joe Williams suggested adding the wording of "estate sale" to the definition of garage sale. City Attorney Brett Brewer stated he would add the language.

Mr. Holland said this resolution is approving submittal of an application for a hazard mitigation grant from the The Texas Division of Emergency Management to pay for eq. basin and it is a 90/10 matching grant.
