DISCUSS AND CONSIDER WITH POSSIBLE ACTION THE PLANTING OF TREES AT THE OLD CITY CEMETERY ENTRANCE	Emily Morrow reviewed Dr. Burkett's visit last month with the board and said she asked if KJB would be interested in planting trees at the Old City Cemetery. Judy Angle suggested little gem magnolias. Emily offered to go look and see what she could find in regards to the trees. Helen Keller voiced a concern about water. Judy Angle suggested placing the trees in pots at the cemetery entrance and then, after the historical event is over, planting them elsewhere in the city. Helen Keller stated she is not an advocate for pursuing placing the trees until water is available. Judy Angle suggested mums and some of the blue pots for decoration for the historical event. Emily Morrow made a motion to spend funds from the discretionary fund to decorate the entrance at the cemetery. Judy Angle amended the motion to limit the expenditure to \$400. Second, John Mark Lester. All voted "Aye'.
