INVOCATION	Glynda Corley
CITIZEN PARTICIPATION	No one came forward.
MINUTE APPROVAL	Glynda Corley made a motion to approve the minutes. Second, by Donna Brumbelow. All voted "Aye"
FINANCIAL REPORT	Greg Lowe reported \$18,857.88 in the beautification fund and \$965.50 in the pre-approved expenditure fund.
DISCUSSION ON BOARD MEMBERS AND APPOINTMENTS WITH POSSIBLE ACTION ON NOMINATIONS	Greg Lowe told the board that all nominations and re-appointments would be moved to January each year. He also told the group that Helen Keller was resigning from the board and a replacement needed to be found. Emily Morrow will reach out to Pam Duke and Amanda Childress. Greg Lowe will reach out to Letitia Horace and see what her plans are. Greg Lowe asked everyone to think about nominations for Chair and Co-Chair.
DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION KJB BECOMING A KEEP TEXAS BEAUTIFUL AFFILIATE	Donna Brumbelow said she and Emily checked into this a few years ago and it is a lot of work. The consensus with the board was that they were not interested in becoming an affiliate at this time.
UPDATE ON BENCHES AND TRASH CANS THAT WERE REMOVED FROM DOWNTOWN FOR THE SIDEWALK PROJECT	Greg Lowe told the board the benches and trash cans will be reinstalled by the contractor on the sidewalk project.
UPDATE ON BOLTON PARK	Emily Morrow said she and several volunteers worked in the park. Manuel Pazano brought in 4 yards of compost and removed the roses. Emily is meeting with a student later today about volunteering.
DISCUSSION ON BLUE FLOWER POTS - POSSIBLE ARTIFICIAL FOLIAGE	Emily Morrow suggested putting artificial foliage in them. There were discussions about moving the pots to the museum. During the discussion, the blue benches for the library were brought up. Helen Keller asked if those benches could go to Lincoln Park. Emily Morrow is going to reach out to Lititia Horace to see if she wants them installed there. No final decision was made on the pots.
UPDATE ON CONCRETE BENCHES	Judy Angle said they rescheduled going to see the benches until Thursday.
YARD SIGN LOCATIONS UPDATE	Helen Keller suggested putting a sign at Southern Serape downtown. Judy Angle said Joe Angle is going to start helping them put the signs up. She suggested switching to the plastic type "bandit" signs because the current signs are too heavy.
