FINANCIAL REPORT	City Clerk Greg Lowe reported \$20,741.73 in the beautification fund and \$1,344.90 in the pre-approved expenditures fund.
DISCUSS AND CONSIDER WITH POSSIBLE ACTION THE ELECTION OF CHAIR AND VICE CHAIR FOR THE UPCOMING YEAR	Glynda Corley made a motion to nominate Todd Yocham as chair. Todd Yocham added to the motion to nominate Emily Morrow as vice chair. Second, for both motions by Judy Angle. All voted "Aye"
DISCUSS AND CONSIDER WITH POSSIBLE ACTION NOMINATION OF A NEW BOARD MEMBER	Chair Emily Morrow said Mr. Ray Penn had not called her back in regard to the position. Emily Morrow made a motion to nominate Mrs. Caroline Wilde to fill the vacancy. Second, by Todd Yocham. All voted "Aye"
DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION EXISTING BOARD MEMBERS	The City Clerk said he placed this on the agenda in anticipation of re-appointments for the upcoming year. Mr. Lowe said there are no new re-appointments until January 2025. No action was taken.
DISCUSS AND CONSIDER WITH POSSIBLE ACTION THE PURCHASE OF AN ADDITIONAL TOMATO FOR THE NORTH 69 ENTRANCE AND IT'S DECORATION	Todd Yocham said the Lion's club had moved their tomato from the Hwy 69 N. entrance and an additional tomato was needed to make the entrance look more balanced.
