CITIZEN PARTICIPATION	New Parks Director Devin Fredrickson introduced himself.
MINUTE APPROVAL	Donna Brumbelow made a motion to approve the minutes. Second, by Janis Adams. All voted "Aye"
FINANCIAL REPORT	City Clerk Greg Lowe reported \$21791.63 in the beautification fund and \$1,344.90 in the pre-approved expenditure fund.
DISCUSS AND CONSIDER WITH POSSIBLE ACTION THE PURCHASE OF MAPLE TREES FOR BOLTON PARK AND POSSIBLY THE MUSEUM	Emily Morrow said a 1.75 diameter tree would be \$95 and a 3.25" tree is \$425. Donna Brumbelow asked how many trees were needed for the park. Emily said the group would need to go measure. After discussion, it was decided two or three members would meet Devin Fredrickson at the park to determine how many trees are needed. The board felt the smaller trees would be the appropriate ones to purchases. Donna Brumbelow made a motion to approve up to \$1,000 to purchase the maple trees for Bolton Park. Second, by Janis Adams. All voted "Aye"
QUESTIONS, COMMENTS, DISCUSSION	Todd Yocahm said he spoke with the Lion's Club about moving the tomato back to the north entrance. They said they had to rent a tractor to move theirs. Devin Fredrickson said he could get his crew to relocate the tomato. Emily Morrow stated that members are required to work so many hours per year outside the meetings. City Clerk Greg Lowe reviewed the current by-laws and said members are required to work 12 hours per year doing various things outside the meetings. Glynda Corley said she and Judy Angle would begin working on new sign locations in late March or April.
